

The Jewel Ornament of Liberation is a meditation manual composed by the Enlightened Tibetan Master, Lord Gampopa (1079–1153). It is the complete foundation for Buddhist study and practice covering the initial entry into the path and continuing through the achievement of Buddhahood. Khenchen Rinpoche received the transmission of this essential text from Khunu Lama Rinpoche who once said, "If you know the Jewel Ornament, you can say that you know the Buddhadharma."

Cakrasamvara Empowerment, Teachings and Drubchen Retreat (July 2 – 9) and Cakrasamvara Retreat Intensive (July 11 – 29)



Cakrasamvara Drupchen: Empowerment, Teachings and Practice July 2-9 (online and in-person)

Cakrasamvara is highest yoga tantra practice in the Vajrayana Buddhist tradition. Cakrasamvara is the main yidam of all Kagyu lineages, and the central deity practiced in the Fivefold Path of Mahamudra of the Drikung Kagyu Lineage. Cakrasamvara is centered around using bliss and emptiness to recognize and rest in our true nature or Buddha essence. It is the path that has been relied upon by the hundred of siddhas of India and Tibet. It is the swift path for those with faith, diligence, and wisdom. It is the heart nectar of the Buddha's teachings. Yidam practice is a very special tantric path in which one transforms one's normal, samsaric experience of reality into an extraordinary experience of the true state of all phenomena.

This is a profound opportunity to deepen your practice of Cakrasamvara under the

guidance of Drupon Rinchen Dorjee Rinpoche. On July 2 the Cakrasamvara drupchen begins with an empowerment. Each day there will be teachings and practice sessions. The drupchen ends on July 9 and preparations for the retreat begins on July 10.

The Drupchen will be streamed live on YouTube channel <u>here</u>. Registration is required for online participation to confirm commitment to the samayas and receive the texts.

REQUIRED COMMITMENT

Anyone who wants to receive the Cakrasamvara empowerment and do the practice must commit to the samaya. The samaya is to never lose your love and to recite 100,000 Cakrasamvara mantras in your lifetime.

You will need a blindfold. Typically a red cloth, wide enough to cover your eyes and hook over each ear is used.

<u>Cakrasamvara Retreat Intensive July 11 – 29 (in-person only)</u>

For the Practice Retreat Intensive, participants will need to pay for their food orders, which staff will deliver during the retreat, and participants will prepare their own meals during the retreat. The practice retreat will begin on July 11.

This deity yoga intensive retreat is a unique combination of solitary and group practice. The retreat is entirely silent except for the regular question and answer sessions with the retreat master. The rare conditions of this retreat will help deepen your practice of Cakrasamvara under the guidance of such a precious teacher!

Please note, attendance of the drupchen is required in order to attend the Cakrasamvara Practice Retreat Intensive. Since accommodations are limited priority will first be given to those attending both the drupchen and practice retreat intensive.
